4th and 5th Grade: Mr. Salah's 5th Grade

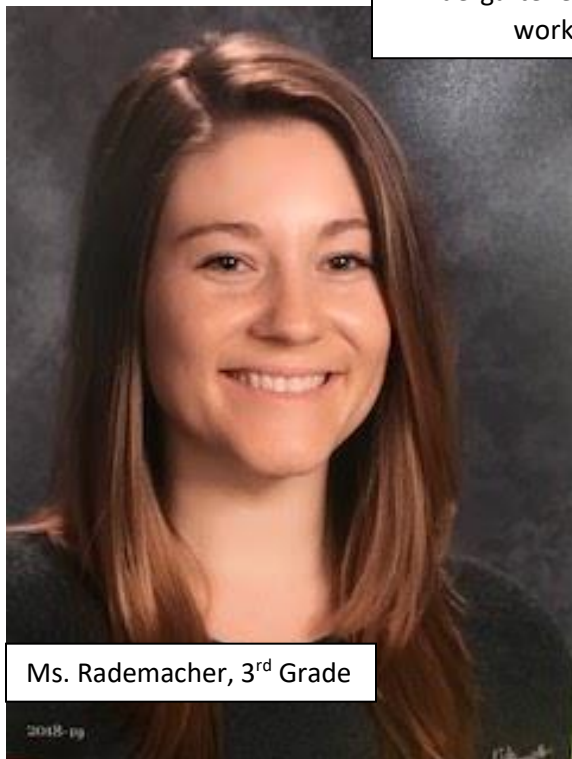
6th, 7th, and 8th Grade: Ms. Noel's 6th Grade



Teacher Feature: Ms. Rademacher is one of the 3rd grade teachers. This is her 1st year teaching 3rd grade at UACS.

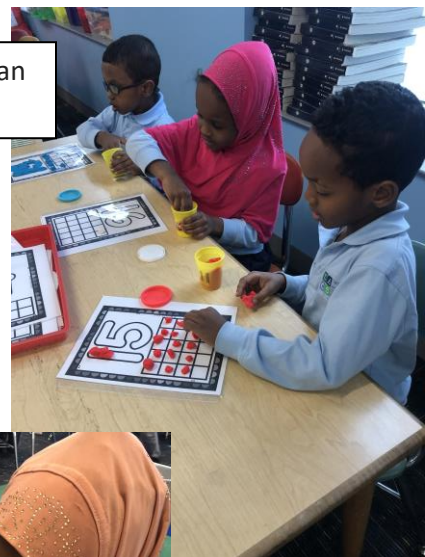
Where were you born? Miami Florida	What is your proudest accomplishment? My proudest accomplishment is teaching in Minneapolis.
