UACS K-8 News:

Planners: Students in grades 3 – 8 should have a Universal Academy School Planner. If the planner is lost it is \$5 to replace. Parents should check the planner each night to make sure students are completing all of their homework. Parents should sign the bottom of each day in the planner so teachers know that parents are involved.

Wednesday Envelope: All students from k-8th grade should have a Wednesday Envelope that goes home every Wednesday and returns every Thursday. Parents should remove all the contents from the Wednesday envelope, and sign the front of the envelope. If the envelope is lost it is \$3 to replace.

Uniform: All students from Preschool – 8th grade must wear a complete UACS uniform. UACS does not allow students to wear sweat shirts or jackets during class.

Homework: All students at UACS receive homework in their core subjects Monday – Thursday. It is possible that students have homework over the weekend, but it is not standard. Students are expected to complete homework and turn it in the following day. Late homework MAY be accepted. It is up to the teacher.

Reading Log: All students in K-8th grade must complete a reading log. Students should every night and write down what they're reading. Students may need to write a 3 sentence summary of what they read each night. Parents must sign the reading log to make sure that the student is completing the work.

6th, 7th, and 8th Grade: Ms. Noel's 6th Grade



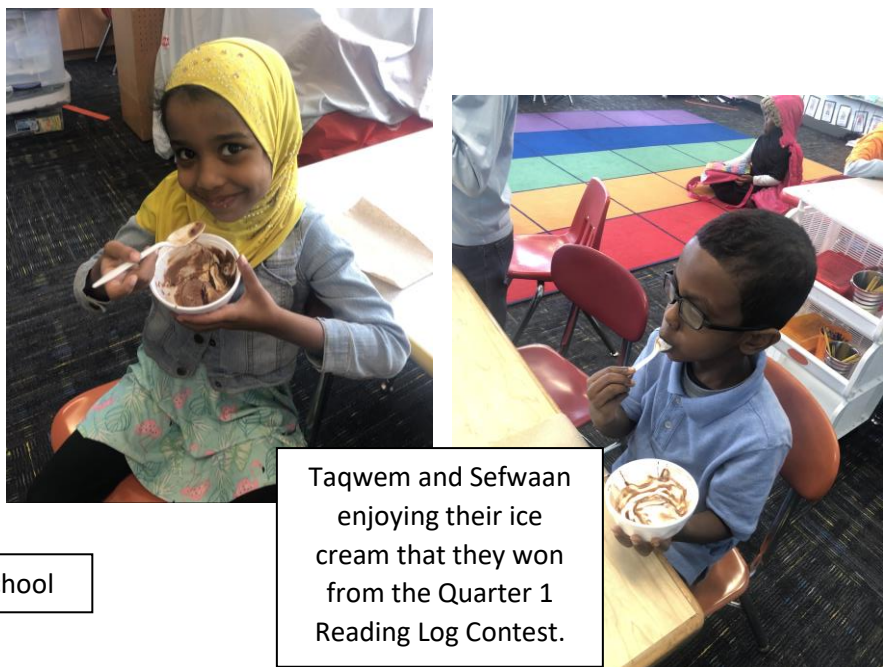
Teacher Feature: Ms. Brenda is the Preschool teacher at UACS. It is her second year teaching Preschool at UACS.
