- **Services:** Provides sliding fee scale services for uninsured, including individual and family counseling, cultural transition counseling, family violence counseling, medication monitoring, and mental health day treatment.
- **Specialty:** Specializes in working with Somali women and has staff who are African-American, American Indian, Spanish-speaking, and Asian and African bicultural.
- **Location:** Near the Franklin Avenue light rail stop.
- **Walk-in service:** Available for mental health care between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
